## The 3RD Man

*the 3RD Man is a vineyard project based in Waipara, North Canterbury. All wines are made from small vineyard parcels selected for their vine age, unique soils and location within the valley. Vineyards are managed so that yields are low and concentration remains high. The wines are made using only indigenous yeasts from the vineyards, and the use of traditional small batch processes ensuring the wines remain unique reflections of the vineyard and the vintage. Stylistically, the wines accentuate balance over power, complexity of flavour, structure and elegance.*
